In three games, the midfielder tallied five points, including his first two collegiate goals in a win over Eastern Nazarene. He currently ranks second on the team with five points.

The Beacons took two out of three last week, fueled by freshman midfielder **Romeo Zeqo (Malden, MA)**, who netted his first two collegiate goals, including the game-winner, in a 4-1 win over Eastern Nazarene on September 15. Zeqo assisted freshman forward

Henry Marin (Haverhill, MA) on UMB's only goal vs. Plymouth State to give him five points for the week. Sophomore forward **Antonio Monteiro (Boston, MA)** also netted a pair of goals during the rain-soaked match with Eastern Nazarene as sophomore forward **Emile Pierre-Louis (Medford, MA)** found him for both scores.

UMass Boston junior defender **Mike Reda (Medford, MA)** provided all the offense in the team's 1-0 victory over Suffolk to open the week, when he converted a direct kick with less than five minutes to go in the first half and freshman goalkeeper **Paul Maniscalco (Boston, MA)** turned away all seven shots he faced to record his second shutout of the season. Prior to the Beacons loss on Saturday, the team began the season 4-0 for the second time in three years under Head Coach Myles Berry.

The Beacons winning streak was halted this weekend as they dropped three matches in Little East Conference play at host Rhode Island College. The Anchorwomen took UMB in three games as did Eastern Connecticut State University the following morning and UMass Dartmouth came away with a 3-1 victory. Senior middle blocker **Stephanie Adams (Whitman, MA)** continued her strong service game with 15 saves in 10 games and was a force on the attack as well, hitting .317 for the weekend, while averaging 2.3 kills per game to go with 2.4 digs and eight blocks. Freshman outside hitter **Tanya Beckford (Framingham, MA)** was solid on the weekend with 17 kills and 13 aces, while coming up with 10 digs and a block and sophomore outside hitter **Denise Hill (Toa Baja, PR)** smashed 18 kills to go

with five aces, six blocks and nine digs.

BULLIS NAMED LITTLE EAST ROOKIE OF THE WEEK

Laura Bullis (Canfield, OH) was named Little East Conference Rookie of the Week for her play during the week of September 12-18

The forward tallied a hat trick to lead UMB over Mitchell on September 14 and became the first Beacons' women's player to net three goals in a game since 1996.

Peppering the Pequots

The Beacons won their first match of the year with a 6-0 drubbing of Mitchell College on September 14. Freshman forward **Laura Bullis (Canfield, OH)** netted a hat trick to lead the Beacons, while senior midfielder **Andrea Maillett (Reading, MA)** tallied six points on a pair of goals and two assists. The match marked the first time that UMB had scored six goals in a match since it defeated Lesley University, 6-1, on October 10, 2000. It marks the largest margin of victory for UMass Boston since a 6-0 victory over Emerson College on September 16, 1997 and Bullis' three

scores are the most in a game for a UMB player since Shannon Murphy netted three at Johnson & Wales University in a 5-0 UMass Boston triumph on September 14, 1996.

Senior defender **Meghan Tansey (Lake Arrowhead, CA)** capped the scoring with her first goal of the season and freshman midfielder **Casey Turner (Melrose, MA)** added an assist on one of Bullis' goals. Junior keeper **Denise B. Ridge (Milton, MA)** was untested in the match to earn her first career shutout.

Freshman midfielder **Katherine Wall (Arlington, MA)** knotted the Beacons' match at Plymouth State at 1-1 on Saturday with less than five minutes to go in the first half, but the Panthers netted three unanswered goals in the second half to secure the win. Ridge stopped nine shots for UMass Boston.
